












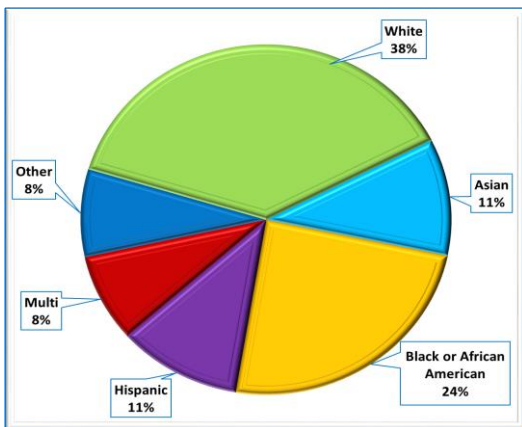

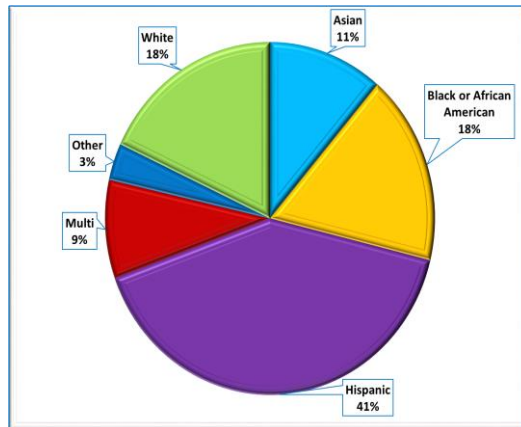

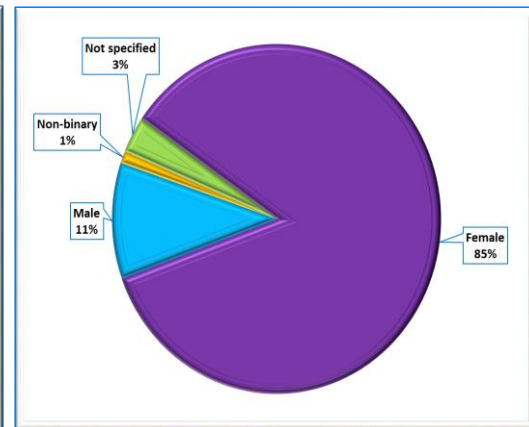
Faculty/Staff Race/Ethnicity
