AI is changing Healthcare

Our aim is to define standards and rules in health AI to advance the right to trys, interests, and concerns of patient communities in health technology.

Patient-Led Governance

Patients should be central to creating AI healthcare rules and standards.



Independent Duty to Patients

AI in healthcare must be designed with a responsibility to prioritize patient welfare, mirroring the duty upheld by physicians.



Transparency

Patients must be informed when their data contributes to AI model development, when AI influences care decisions. When AI is used to determine treatment, evidence should be provided.



Self-Determination

Patients should have the option to choose or refuse AI interventions in their care.



Identity Security and Privacy

AI must ensure patient safety, privacy, and identity protection while respecting their choices.



Right of Action

Patients have the legal authority to prevent and rectify any harm caused by healthcare AI.



Shared Benefit

AI must first and foremost benefit those who are most at risk from its potential harms-patients.
